- Late return of hourly hired boats and / or equipment will be charged at an additional hourly rate immediately on return.

- All trips are weather dependant and will not be credited but rescheduled should there be changes due to weather conditions.
- Cancellations of boat hire are required to be within a min. of 24 Hrs. before departure or else will be charged in full.
